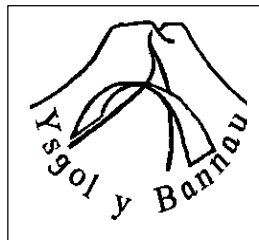

The year was significantly disrupted by Covid-19, with classes self-isolating and with the Lockdown during most of the Spring Term 2021. We have worked together to provide the best possible education with the ever changing restrictions imposed on us.

I would also like to thank you, our families, for your fantastic support and understanding throughout a difficult year.

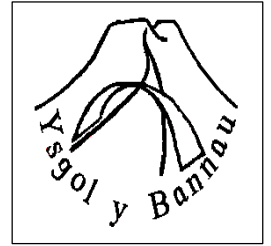

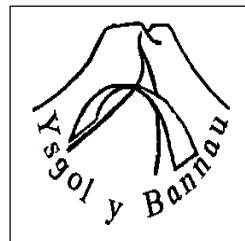

The Annual Meeting

A meeting will be arranged if required by parents-

Section 94 School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 (the Act) makes important changes to the previous legislative arrangements in respect of the Annual Parent / Governor Meetings. It provides new arrangements whereby parents can request a meeting with a governing body.

However, the parents will need to satisfy the four statutory requirements when calling a meeting which are as follows:-

**that the parents of 10% of registered pupils, or the parents of 30 registered pupils (whichever is the lower) must sign a petition requesting a meeting*

**the meeting must be for the purpose of discussing matters relating to the school*

**the maximum number of meetings that parents can request in any school year is three*

**there must be sufficient school days left in the school year to allow a meeting to be held*

Further:-

Meetings must be held before the end of a 254 day period

**the 25 day period commences the day after receipt of the petition but does not include any day which is not a school day*

**if another meeting is required to be held as a result of a different petition, the 25 day period will not commence until the day after the other meeting has been held*

**there must be sufficient school days left in the school year to allow a meeting to be held before the end of the 25 day period*

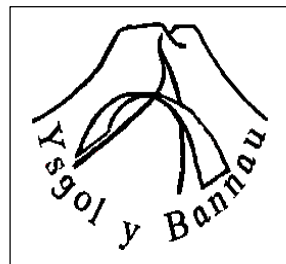
**meetings will be open to all parents of registered pupils at the school, Head and any other person invited by the governing body*

**notification of meetings to parents must include the date, time and venue of the meeting and the matter or matters to be discussed.*

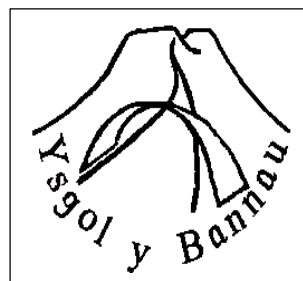
The School has a Toilet Policy which complies with statutory requirements. It outlines the quality and quantity of toilets in the school and the provision and care available for pupils with special toilet needs.

A lovely silver one shilling coin. Made in 1935 with King George V's head looking back at everyone whose hands I went through. I used to pass from one person's hand to another. From the housewife to shopkeeper, to shop managers, to the banks. I have even been in the hands of famous people! Round and round across the UK travelling in peoples' hands and helping people every day.



I was used during the war to help buy materials to make a bomb shelter and after the war I helped to rebuild the country.

All the coins were so important, pounds, shillings and pennies.

All working together to help the country.

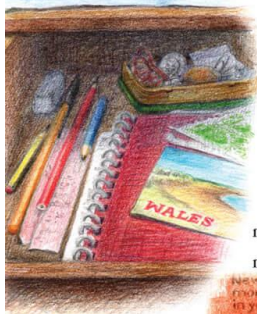


When the Royal Mint made the new coins in February 1971,

I no longer paid for food or rent. I wasn't needed to pay for anything.

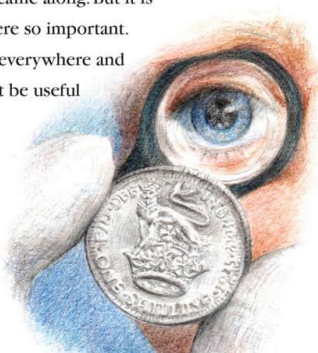
No more travelling from hand to hand across the country. I was thrown in the back of a drawer and didn't see the lights for years.

I am going on a new adventure. Collectors everywhere and museums trying to grab hold of me. I may not be useful now but I am very special again.



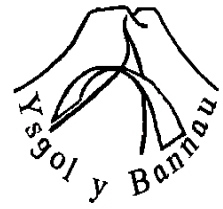
